To Members of the Press:

The Tokyo International Film Festival (TIFF) will hold an **Opening Ceremony on Saturday, October 31, 2020.** Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 we will not be able to hold a Red Carpet event of the same scale as in past years at Roppongi Hills Arena. However, we hope you will join us and our special guests at the **Tokyo International Forum Hall C (Hall C)** on October 31.

PRE-REGISTRATION IS MANDATORY

To prevent COVID-19 infections, pre-registration is mandatory for all press members who have been accredited to cover this year's Tokyo International Film Festival. Please fill in the pre-registration form for each press event on your My Page on our website <u>by 3:00 pm on October 30 (Fri)</u>. Pre-registration will open from 10:00 am on October 28 (Wed.) If the number of registrations exceeds the limit, seating will be determined by drawing lots. The TIFF Press Office will inform you if your registration must regrettably be cancelled <u>by 6:00 pm on October 30 (Fri)</u>.

PRESS PASSES ARE REQUIRED

Press members who wish to cover the opening events should plan to pick up your press pass before the events on Oct. 31. Please come early to the **Tokyo International Forum Hall C** before sign-in.

Guests will walk on the red carpet by film title and make a short greeting.

2:30 pm End of Red Carpet arrivals / move to the Opening Ceremony

*TIFF staff will guide all the media who cover the Red Carpet Arrivals into the hall after the ceremony is over.

*There will be no sound bites.



*Third priority to Journalists who will cover the Red Carpet Arrivals and Ceremony without taking photos

*No entries and exits will be allowed during the ceremony.

*All members of the media covering the opening events must be properly attired. Jackets are required for men.

To Prevent COVID-19 Infections

- Please keep the number of accompanying staff to a minimum when covering an event.
- Please wear a mask and use the hand sanitizer at the registration desk on the day of the event.
- Your temperature will be taken at the desk, and if it exceeds 37.5 degrees Celsius, you will not be permitted to enter. We must also ask you to refrain from coming to the venue if you have such symptoms such as a fever, a cough, fatigue, or a general feeling of unwellness.
- Please note that this information is only for media outlets that have been specifically sent invitations. Please refrain from providing your coverage to outlets other than those that have been invited.
